Beaver Valley Ski Club Installing New Doppelmayr Quad Chairlift

Markdale, On Canada – Beaver Valley Ski Club is currently installing a new fixed-grip, quad chairlift over the Hutchinson Highway ski run, with construction expected to be complete in early December, prior to the Club's planned opening in late December 2016.

The new chairlift and terminal, purchased in St-Jérôme, Québec from Doppelmayr Canada Ltd., will replace the Hutchinson Triple Chairlift that serviced Beaver Valley's main ski runs until spring 2016. It is being installed in the same location as the original 34 year old (circa: 1982) Hutchinson Triple.

The new Doppelmayr will bring an improved operating speed, moving at 2.3 meters per second and reducing passenger ride time from 6.8 minutes to 5.5 minutes; it will carry 17 more chairs (112 vs 95) than the Hutchinson Triple; and it will also include a loading conveyor system to assist passengers onto the chairlift. These things, combined with the move from a triple to a quad, will bring increased uphill capacity to the Club and will continue to ensure that lift lines are seldom a problem at Beaver Valley.

The private Beaver Valley Ski Club is situated in the serene and picturesque valley along the Niagara Escarpment and is home to 29 trails covering 104 skiable acres. These trails are serviced by 5 chairlifts and one carpet lift. The ski club currently has a limited number of Trial Memberships available and is open to the public for special groups, ski days and events.
